The Mother & Child Health Initiative is part of the **CALIPER** program at SickKids. The CALIPER program focuses on developing healthy reference standards for blood tests in children and adolescents. To date, CALIPER has recruited over 12,000 healthy children and adolescents and studied over 185 laboratory tests! As part of the CALIPER program, the Mother & Child Health Initiative aims to establish a comprehensive database of blood test values in healthy Canadian pregnant women for the first time.
