



Volunteer with CALIPER

Eligibility

The ideal CALIPER volunteer will demonstrate some combination of the following skills and education:

- · Completion of OSSD or grade 12 equivalent
- · Completion of or enrollment in post-secondary education
- · Must be 18 years of age or older
- Experience working with children and families
- · Reliability and ability to maintain regular shift attendance
- · Commitment to ongoing learning and development
- Ability to work well individually and in a team setting
- · Good interpersonal and communication skills; non-judgmental and able to initiate conversation

Commitment

Office shifts are typically scheduled in three-hour timeslots from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. or from 1 to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, on a bi-weekly or monthly basis. We ask for a minimum time commitment of six months. We also request that volunteers attend at least one clinic per month.

Application Process

- Submit a resume and transcript (if applicable) to <u>caliper.project@sickkids.ca</u>
- Selected candidates will be invited for an interview and successful applicants will then be connected with the Volunteer Resources Department at SickKids
- Volunteer Resources will ensure that each candidate meets the following onboarding requirements to volunteer at SickKids:
 - ✓ Vulnerable Sector Search
 - ✓ Volunteer Immunization Form
 - ✓ Reference Check
 - ✓ Volunteer Agreements and Personal Information Form
 - ✓ Mandatory Hospital Policies Document (iLearn Training)
 - ✓ Volunteer Resources Orientation
- Once the volunteer successfully fulfills these requirements, Volunteer Resources will be in touch to confirm that the volunteer is cleared and granted permission to start with the team
- The CALIPER coordinator will arrange for the volunteer to attend a CALIPER-specific orientation and subsequent job shadowing.
