Eligibility

The ideal CALIPER ambassador will demonstrate some combination of the following skills and education:

- Enrollment in grade 7-12
- Experience with community initiatives
- · Commitment to ongoing learning and development
- Ability to work well individually and in a team setting
- · Good interpersonal and communication skills; non-judgmental and able to initiate conversation

Commitment

CALIPER Student Ambassadors are expected to:

- · Promote the CALIPER Program before an upcoming clinic at their school
 - Sharing promotional materials
 - Informing students of the upcoming clinic to encourage participation (visiting classrooms, sharing with friends)
- Promote the CALIPER Program in the fall/winter terms of the school year
 - Sharing promotional materials (peers, friends, family members, neighbors, community centres)
 - o Re-sharing CALIPER social media posts
 - Poster presentation on behalf of the CALIPER Program to the school (optional)

Note: All activities will take place outside of the Hospital for Sick Children
